Over the last 15 years, God has grown Stone Arbor Church from a group of 12 who started the church into about 600 weekly attendees. We have rejoiced as 241 people have been baptized over the years. We trained up and sent out 2 church plants and launch teams, Valley Lights Church in Santa Clarita in 2020 and Pathfinder Church in Reno Nevada is 2023. We have teamed together to create a warm, welcoming place to invite people to take their next steps with Jesus.

Even as a portable Church, God has established and grown Stone Arbor. We believe God is calling us to do more and reach further. Because of this, we have once again set out in faith to BUILD STONE ARBOR.

In 2020, we purchased the former Riverside Swim and Tennis Center and are now on a journey to make this space our church home. We have secured the land, renovated the current buildings, and are now further developing the campus. We've brought new life to a historic corner of Riverside and we envision that God will use this new campus to bring hope and new life to our community.

Stone Arbor church is committed to sharing and living out the life-changing gospel of Jesus Christ in Riverside, CA. We are a place of relational rest, life change, and training in truth. Our vision goes beyond us; our hope is to develop a launchpad that reproduces a strong kingdom culture and strategic, new ministries.

WHY THIS LOCATION?



The City of Riverside,

Developing a church campus in the exact heart of Riverside gives us permanence, visibility, and a ministry advantage. Building out this campus communicates to our city and neighbors that we are here to stay, and they can count on us to be their church home for decades to come.

A STRATEGIC, VISIBLE CENTERPOINT

- 1. There are **4.2 million people in the Inland Empire** and only 200 Southern Baptist Churches.
- 2. Riverside has 4 universities and approximately **47,000 college students**, making this city a pipeline for training kingdom leaders.
- 3. The Glenhaven Campus is **visible to 100,000 cars** per day.

PHASES OF DEVELOPMENT

To get us where we are, the community of Stone Arbor has responded to God in faith and generosity. To date, over \$2,000,000 of Stone Arbor donations have gone towards the development of our property.

Phase 1 - GET HERE. Purchase property and renovate existing buildings

NEXT STEP: PHASE 2

Build: A 175-seat, multi-use building with a capacity of 175 indoors, and optional outdoor overflow, giving us a permanent venue for Sunday worship services

Build: A new driveway and upper parking lot to accommodate larger gatherings

Build: A new restroom building for an increased campus capacity

FUNDING PHASE 2



Mobilizing Phase 2 construction will require \$2,750,000. In faith, we are asking God to provide - and we anticipate funding will come from multiple sources.

SOURCES OF FUNDING

Stone Arbor has been approved to borrow up to 70% of the Phase 2 costs.

Fundraising the remaining 30% (\$800,000) will mobilize construction.

Gifts beyond the 30% mark will reduce borrowed funds.



Phase 3 - REACH OUT

We will expand for growth by building the main auditorium and completing all on-site parking.







Phase 4 - BUILD OUT

We will build space for the Next Generation by adding a new Stone Arbor Kid's building and expanding the existing kid space.





Phase 5 - PASS IT ON

We intend to pay off all borrowed funds in order to free up future ministry.
